If history is your thing, must-sees are Monroe County Museum, Forsyth's historic sites and Confederate Cemetery. Don't miss the opportunity to explore nearby Culloden, one of seven Monroe County sites listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Visit Culloden Cemetery to learn about the last Civil War battle fought in Georgia after the South surrendered. Hungry? Stop in at Lockett's Kuntry Cooking.

Enjoy the public art installations of murals and sculptures sprinkled around town. Looking for a fun challange? Start at the Welcome Center and join the Forsyth Foxhunt.



The Forsyth Foxhunt is a downtown based scavenger hunt. Small fox statues are hidden foxhund around different shops, businesses, and

historic buildings, taking you on an adventure through Forsyth. It is free, and sure to delight all ages!



We have celebrations all year round! Visit Forsyth in March and celebrate the advent of spring at our annual Forsythia Festival! Cool off with us at the Fall Festival on the Square and the Footsteps Through Forsyth Art Walk, or take a short drive to Juliette for the Green Tomato Festival in October.

Stroll around the square any time of year to enjoy Monroe County's 1896 red-brick Victorian courthouse and the charming turn-of-the-century environment. If you happen to be in town during a performance at the delightfully intimate historic Rose Theater or the new Monroe Fine Arts Center, you're in for a treat.

Make a splash at the High Falls Water Park, featuring two thrilling waterslides. Or, nearby at High Falls State Park, enjoy the sound of the Towaliga River as it crashes down the falls, the beautiful trails, the grist mill and power house ruins and more. Hungry? Give one of the local eateries like the Hot Dog House or Falls View Restaurant a try.

With its location on I-75, Forsyth is a great place to rest and renew for a day (or several) as you travel along Georgia's main thoroughfare. Check out Magnolia's Med Spa. Or take a scenic drive past cattle ranches and unspoiled forests. Don't miss the Splash Pad and Pumptrack while in Forsyth. Practice your aim at Meadows Gun Club in Smarr.

Explore the City of Forsyth for all its hidden gems and for a fine meal at an award-winning restaurant and a good night's sleep in one of several comfortable hotel/motel accommodations or the KOA campground. Forsyth KOA has mini golf and mining for arrowheads, gems and crystals. Open to the public daily.

re the explorations of history and genealogy your passion or do adventures in dining whet your appetite?
Do you find treasures in the great outdoors or do you crave the secret corners of intriguing antique shops? Do the glories of Hollywood beckon to you, or do you seek the simple pleasures of strolling through streets that remind you of a kinder and gentler yesteryear? Can you find the hidden green tomato in the welcoming train mural across the street from the depot or the flying Kite Mural at the City Park? Whatever your heart's desire, it awaits you here.

A LONG, LONG TIME AGO

- See the campus of the historic TIFT COLLEGE, now the home of the administrative headquarters for the Georgia Department of Corrections, fronting on I-75, or head over to and tour the historic Hubbard Women's Dormitory.
- In the wake of Sherman's "March to the Sea," Forsyth served as a special hospital camp. Every available shelter in town was used: the courthouse, Monroe Female College, the old Lumpkin Hotel, stores, and even private homes. Eventually, tent hospitals had to be erected for the multitude of wounded soldiers. Today, you can visit the CONFEDERATE CEMETERY, where 300 of those soldiers are buried. - Agriculture has been the backbone of Monroe County's economy for a couple of hundred years. You can see why when you stop in at the FORSYTH FARMERS MARKET,






